Module: WHAT IS WORSHIP?

Worship is something that can really only be experienced fully when we have an authentic knowledge of God and an understanding of who we are in relation to God the Father. Once we have that knowledge, we can begin to explore who Jesus is and what He has done for us, as well as develop an appreciation and an openness for the Holy Spirit and His work in our lives. In this module we will be taking a closer look at the *what*, *who*, *when*, and *why* of worship and understand that all of the answers can be found when we come to terms with our *identity* in God.

Lesson 1, **What is Worship Really?**, helps students to develop an understanding of the general concept of worship and begin to understand that it is much bigger than just singing a few songs on a Sunday morning at church.

Lesson 2, **That's My Father!**, will explore the connection that we can have with God, and will encourage students to think about themselves in relation to Him. When we think about who God is, and who we are, we can't help but express our thanks and gratitude that he desires a relationship with us! Students will also consider what "family resemblance" looks like in the family of God.

Lesson 3, **Same Time, Same Place**, will invite students to think about when worship takes place, pushing them to think outside of the box and identify times in their own lives when they have worshiped out of routine or tradition, as opposed to a genuine expression of love. They will also consider the reasoning behind worship and why we are to engage in it.
