

Born to GO

Born to GO is a call for students to explore a life of mission, here, there, and everywhere! Born to GO focuses on a life of service, mission, ministry, legacy—by whatever name it is called—in our own neighbourhoods and around the world. Born to GO is about fostering a missional life, a life lived to make change in the world, to leave a legacy.

For the instructor, Born to GO will take some advance preparation. It is essential that you read these three lessons several weeks before you lead them, as you may end up on the telephone recruiting a guest or in a committee meeting arranging a worship service. A real call to students to explore mission as a lifestyle emerges from this series. If you are not a pastor in your church, this series may provide you with a good opportunity to work with the pastor of your church to make these things happen.

- In Mission.Here, students will explore ways that their group can participate in serving the local community, the needs around your own church.
- In Mission.There, students will have the chance to hear from and interact with a person who has served “over there” in foreign mission. Students will also brainstorm ways that they could participate in mission, there, either by going or by supporting what is happening overseas.
- Finally, in Mission.Everywhere, students will challenge one another to a lifestyle and legacy of mission. The lesson ends with an opportunity to hold a commissioning service for your students, either as part of the lesson or as part of a worship service in your church. Whether the students see themselves as high school campus missionaries or community missionaries, you’ll be amazed at how a commissioning can galvanize your church around your youth ministry.

Making change is easy once you’ve decided how to do it. The challenge is to actually set aside time to build a plan. So get to building. The world needs you. The world at home. The world away. The world today!
