Blizzard Week I (Jan 29-31) Speaker: Jason Hildebrand



Blizzard Week 2 (feb 5-7) SPEAKER MIKE GORDON



Mike didn't grow up in a Christian environment and at 14 he was kicked out of his house because he didn't get along with his mom's boyfriend who broke up the family. The police had to escort him back into his house and he was given a garbage bag and 5 minutes to grab his stuff. Mike shares real and raw stories that took him from a place that was far from God to eventually choosing to follow Jesus and communicate God's truth around the world. While Mike has served as a pastor, he felt God leading him to focus on speaking full-time which has opened the door since 2012 to speak over 1500 to tens of thousands of people, mostly youth. Ultimately, Mike has found his identity in Christ and is helping youth by communicating lessons learned from Jesus in a fresh raw perspective that will uniquely speak to and challenge new believers to mature as Christians in their walk with Christ.
