Previously known as mission trips, COMPASSION EXPERIENCES will aim to equip and mobilize our churches, youth workers, and their youth to compassionately live out the message of Jesus locally, nationally, and internationally.

Experience tells us that youth and young adults are profoundly transformed when they get out of their context and build relationships among those who are different from themselves, whether economically, culturally, or socially. The opportunity for accelerated discipleship occurs as youth have these COMPASSION EXPERIENCES.

There is something about serving and partnering with others that brings transformation from the inside out. CBOQ Youth partners with youth workers across our denomination to help mentor youth as they discover the significance of serving others and demonstrating compassion.

The Compassion Experience-Dominican Republic (CE-DR) is a unique opportunity to impact your students as many of them see God in the global context for the first time and learn from brothers and sisters in the city of Los Alcarrizos.

This is the tenth CBOQ Youth compassion experience to the Dominican Republic in partnership with previously with Care Force International, now with International Teams (IT). IT has led hundreds of people on short-term mission experiences all over the world, such as the Lighthouse Project with Cristian Santiago. This registration package outlines some details to get you started in the application process.

APPLICATION PROCESS

LEADING UP TO YOUR APPLICATION...

- 1) Read this package and be familiar with its contents.
- 2) Pray for everything leading up to, during and after CE-DR.
- 3) Promote CE-DR to your high school students and leaders.
- 4) Get (preliminary) approval from your church leadership (e.g. mission and outreach committee, deacons, church board, etc.).
- 5) Complete the team application form along with a \$100 per church application fee (regardless of the number of participants) before Friday, July 22, 2016.
 - a) We accept up to 29 team members in total. However, we do reserve the right to limit the maximum number of participants per church.
 - b) The \$100 application fee will only be processed if your application is accepted (for online applications, this fee will be refunded if the church application is not accepted). This fee assists CBOQ with initial administrative expenses in facilitating this experience and will NOT be applied to the funds required by IT.
- 6) You'll receive a confirmation by July 31 about your team's acceptance status.

AFTER YOU GET YOUR TEAM ACCEPTANCE

- Once you've received confirmation, you'll also receive the leaders' manual (which will contain additional details) and forms, and an introduction to your Compassion Coordinator.
- 2) All individual applications, responsibility waiver, photocopy of valid passport, and \$200 deposits (payable to "International Teams") are due to CBOQ by September 20, 2016. Once these have been received, the online fundraising page will be activated for each participant.
- 3) You'll regularly meet with your church team for spiritual formation and work on teambuilding and fundraising.
- 4) On Saturday, October 22, 2016 (location TBD), bring your team (students and leaders) to meet together and begin your CE journey.
- 5) On a date TBD, your Compassion Coordinator will meet with you and the other group leaders for an orientation specific to CE-DR.
- 6) All remaining forms (e.g., Medical Waiver, travel insurance, Parental Consent, Police Background Check, Plan to Protect record of completion) and the remaining balance is due to IT by January 20, 2017.
- 7) The team will meet on the evening of Thursday, March 9, 2017 for a commissioning service and orientation. The team will leave on Friday, March 10, 2017 and return on Sat., March 18, 2017.

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW!

Financial Details

CE-DR is a ministry of CBOQ Youth. The cost to carry out this project is \$2250 per person (subject to US exchange rates by January 24, 2017) including all materials, accommodations, DR transportation, flights, travel medical insurance and DR entry fee (does not include passport, vaccinations, cancellation insurance, or other incidental costs).

Note that this is not a registration fee but the cost to carry out the program. All donations are allocated to the program, not the individual; therefore there are no "refunds." In the event that there are surplus funds, they will be directed towards the Lighthouse Project.

All financial payments can be made by cheque (payable to "International Teams") or by credit card through IT's online fundraising page; details about payment options will be outlined in the leaders' manual. All forms will be submitted to CBOQ Youth.

Note that **all finances will go directly to IT** and **all paperwork to CBOQ** except for the first deposit; both the deposit cheque and the initial paperwork ALL go to CBOQ. (Sept 20/16 for deposit and applications/passport copies/responsibility waivers; Jan 20/17 for balance and all remaining forms)

Group Leaders

You'll need at least one leader per seven students (max.) of the same gender (e.g. one female leader for five female students, two male leaders for 12 male students) who has been **screened through your church's child protection policy**. These group leaders will also be your small group leaders and cabin leaders. Small group material will be given to your assigned group leaders in advance. Group leaders should be at least 25 years of age or on church staff.

Security: For the safety and continued success of CE-DR retreats and the Lighthouse Project, security protects you and your students from undue danger, and protects the CE-DR program. They are not harsh, nor do we want to emphasize any of them on this experience. We simply ask for your co-operation.

Youth Leaders: Please note that you will be wholly responsible for the behaviour of your group, and that we reserve the right to send students and leaders home at any point during the experience if we deem it necessary. Each primary group leader must be in full control of their students and leaders. Negligent students and leaders will find their groups fined for negligent behaviour, particularly if vandalism or breakage is an issue. Full replacement and repair costs plus a fine of \$100 will result!
