

There is a critical shortage of qualified youth workers leading our youth ministries. It is crucial that we take seriously the need for our churches to invest into the ongoing equipping of our leaders who are called to reach and engage this next generation with the person and message of Jesus.

There are an increasing number of those entering into point youth ministry leadership roles who have not had or been able to afford the opportunity to receive the necessary youth ministry training develop growing and effective ministries to today's teens.

To respond to this, CBOQ Youth is hosting the Youth Ministry Certificate Training Program (YMCTP) for a cohort group of approximately 10 selected participants.

This highly practical program will span the period of 18 months in which this cohort will gather in 5 in-person intensive sessions (spanning from 2-4 days), access to the Today's Teens Conference in 2025 & 2026, the CBOQ next gen pastors retreat in 2024 & 2025 and a preferred rate for Assembly 2025 & 2026. Each module will be facilitated by CBOQ Youth staff, along with invited youth ministry specialists and ministry leaders from across Canada.

Each participant will be paired up with a veteran youth ministry mentor for monthly coaching sessions, be given access to current youth ministry resources, and have an opportunity to network with other ministry leaders through their cohort experience.

Each graduate will develop their own customized youth ministry manual with foundational and practical resources to lead an effective youth ministry.

WHAT DIFFERENCE WILL THIS TRAINING MAKE?

Imagine what God could do in and through you, your leadership and the ministry you are called tolead through the investment of an 18-month intense mentoring, discipleship and training program. The YMCTP brings together practical classroom studies, the mentoring from a veteran youth ministry leader, and forging of close and trusted friendships with ministry peers.

The aim of this program is that you will develop a theological and biblical understanding and approach to effective youth ministry that will see you create a philosophy of ministry, access practical resources and be able to engage today's teens at the intersection of faith and culture. In the end, you will have your own customized youth ministry handbook.

WHO IS THIS TRAINING DESIGNED FOR?

This program is for ministry leaders who are currently leading the youth ministry (e.g. Youth Pastors, Youth Directors, Associates, Volunteer, etc.) in their local church context. Some may have formal youth ministry training; others may not. A ministry leader applying for this program should be someone who is prepared to invest themselves into a strong interactive educational learning environment along with a desire for mentoring in order to strengthen their knowledge and practical implementation of effective youth ministry.

WHAT ARE THE ANTICIPATED OUTCOMES?

Students completing the CBOQ - Youth Ministry Certificate Training Program will:

- be able to discuss, develop and articulate their ministry plan & philosophy of youth ministry that are both biblically formulated, developmentally appropriate, and culturally competent.
- possess a foundational understanding of Generation Z and Alpha, adolescent development and communication skills necessary to minister to today's youth.
- be equipped with resources in developing healthy relationships with senior pastors, board members and parents.
- Understand the importance of effective **communication**, **management and administrative skills** necessary for effectiveness in youth ministry.
- provide participants with new ideas, resources, templates and access to veteran youth ministry leaders for support and coaching.

WHAT WILL EACH PARTICIPANT EXPERIENCE?

ON-SITE LEARNING EXPERIENCES: There will be 15 days of onsite learning that will involve group work, lecturing, discussion and debrief. Our past facilitators have included:

ONE-ON-ONE MENTORING: You will be paired up with a veteran Youth Ministry leader who will meet with you one-on-one monthly as follow up to on-site learning experiences, leadership challenges, assessment process as well as for personal and spiritual care and personal development.

PRACTICAL READINGS & ASSIGNMENTS: There will be expected readings to be completed before each on-site learning as well as assignments that will be shared within the learning environment with your peers.

WHAT WILL EACH PARTICIPANT EXPERIENCE?

TRAINING COST: \$1000 (CBOQ will match with \$1000/participant)

APPLICATION PROCEDURES
